FAMILY NURSE PARTNERSHIP (FNP)

Aim: To be aware of significant adults living with or having a significant impact on the lives of children.

Information gathered from referral form, forms part of initial assessment. Engagement visit completed to introduce FNP service Home or elsewhere.



Pregnancy visits

- Liaison with Midwifery, School Nursing LAC team.
- Delivery of pregnancy part of FNP programme when client enrolled. Home or elsewhere according to client.
- Weekly visits for 4 weeks. Genogram completed and information transferred onto Family and Child Assessment Form.
- Access Rio records for persons living in the home.
- Fortnightly visits until baby is born.
- Family and Child assessment form completed for baby.



Infancy and Toddler visits

- Delivery of infancy part of FNP programme following baby's birth.
- Weekly visits for 6 weeks.
- Fortnightly visits until child is 20 months old.
- Monthly visits until child aged 2 years.
- Family and child assessment form completed for baby and reviewed if significant changes.
